Feasts this week:

St Cecilia, Virgin, Martyr: Wednesday 22nd

Devotion to St Cecilia, in whose honour a basilica was constructed in Rome in the fifth century, has spread far and wide because of the Passion of Saint Cecilia, which holds her up as a perfect example of a Christian woman, who embraced virginity and suffered martyrdom for the love of Christ. She is thought to have converted her husband and his brother to Christianity, and they were martyred before her. She is the patron saint of musicians.

The Presentation of the Blessed Virgin Mary, Thursday 21st November:

We celebrate this feast in unity with Eastern Christianity, and commemorating the dedication in 543 of the New Basilica of Saint Mary, built next to the Temple at Jerusalem. This feast celebrates Mary's "dedication" of herself to God from her infancy, inspired by the Holy Spirit, whose grace had filled her ever since her immaculate conception.

Eternal father, we honour the holiness and glory of the Virgin Mary. May her prayers bring us the fulness of your lifer and love. Amen.

St Clement 1, Saturday 23rd November: Pope Clement 1, also known as Saint Clement of Rome, is listed by Irenaeus and Tertullian as Bishop of Rome, holding office from 88 to his death in 99. He is considered to be the first Apostolic Father of the Church.

St Columbanus, Saturday 23rd November: (543-615). Well educated and desiring to be a "pilgrim of God". Columban travelled France and founded several monasteries as centres of religion and culture. On his return to Ireland, a shipwreck directed him towards Rome and to the founding of his final monastery at Bobbio in Italy.
