Saints this week:

Saint John Vianney, Priest, Monday 4th August

Born at Lyons in the year 1786. After overcoming tremendous difficulties he was finally ordained a priest. He was given charge of the parish of Ars in the diocese of Belley, and his forthright preaching, personal mortification, prayer and charity renewed it and increased it in a wonderful way. His help to those who came to the sacrament of confession was renowned and people flocked to him from all sides to obtain his advice. He died in the year 1859.

Dedication of St Mary Major, Tuesday 5th August: The doctrine of Mary, Mother of God, was solemnly proclaimed at the Council of Ephesus (431) and afterwards Pope Sixtus III (432-440) erected a basilica at Rome on the Esquiline Hill in honour of the Holy Mother of God, later to be known as St Mary Major. This is the oldest church in the west dedicated to the Blessed Virgin Mary. Pope Francis chose to be buried in St Mary Major. It had been a spiritual anchor throughout his papacy; a place that accompanied him in prayer.

more Saints this week:

St Dominic, Thursday 7th August: Born at Calaruega in Spain about the year 1170. He studied theology at Palencia and became a canon of Osma Cathedral. He preached against the Albigensian heresy and because of the example of his own life this bore great fruit. In order to carry on and increase this work he gathered around him a group of companions and formed the Order of Preachers (Dominicans), becoming one of the four great orders of mendicant friars, along with nuns, sisters and lay associates. He died on 6 August 1221 at Bologna.

Saint Teresa Benedicta of the Cross Sat 9th August (Edith Stein), Virgin and Martyr, Patron of Europe, 1891 -1942. Edith Stein, a Jewish philosopher from Wroclaw in Poland who converted to Catholicism, became a Discalced Carmelite nun and was martyred at Auschwitz during World War 11. Her feast celebrates her intellectual brilliance, deep spirituality, and courage in facing death for her faith and heritage. She is a symbol of reconciliation between faith and reason and a patron of Europe, advocating for peace and understanding.
