Eucharistic Ministers Home visits and support role of Volunteer Chaperone

We need to mention that Eucharistic Ministers who do **home visits** are now required to make visits in pairs and are not to make visits alone. Two Eucharistic Ministers can visit together.

To support this a new role of **Volunteer Chaperone** has been established. A Eucharist Minister can pair up with a Chaperone, who themselves does not need to be a Eucharistic Minister (but cannot be a family member).

Some roles will be working directly with children, young people and vulnerable adults; and will therefore require volunteers to undergo a DBS check before they undertake that role."
