This year the programme will be:-

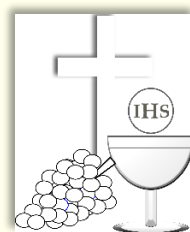
- ☑ Week 15th September letters and forms will be sent to schools and available in Churches - also available on our Parish website:

- ☑ Weekend 20th / 21st September catechists will be available after Mass to answer any questions.
- ☑ **Weekend 27th / 28th September all children attend a Mass with parents to start the programme.**

- ☑ Children and parents attend one session a month to work on the programme. The sessions are held in church during Mass. After Mass there is a short session for parents. Parents pick one church to attend.

- ☑ Dates will be given at the normal Masses.
 - Saturday 5pm in St Marys
 - Sunday 9am in St Richards
 - Sunday 11am in St Francis

Sacraments of Reconciliation & First Holy Communion will take place in May 2026.

Dates will be announced at the monthly sessions.

URGENT REQUEST TO ANY NEW VOLUNTEERS in regulated roles to collect and complete your **Volunteer Registration and DBS application forms** PACKS ARE AVAILABLE IN CHURCH AND THE OFFICE.

We need to mention that Eucharistic Ministers who do **home visits** are now required to make visits in pairs and are not to make visits alone. Two Eucharistic Ministers can visit together.

To support this a new role of **Volunteer Chaperone** has been established. A Eucharist Minister can pair up with a Chaperone, who themselves does not need to be a Eucharistic Minister (but cannot be a family member).
